## *Minutes of May 15, 2018 Meeting*

President Randy Johnson called the meeting to order at approximately 7:40 p.m. He thanked everyone for coming.

### **Reports:**

- Treasurer – Peggy White gave a brief report.
- Secretary – Ann Ebert asked any new members joining tonight to see her at the break to fill out a membership form and pay dues.

### **Announcements:**

- Marian Prigmore, NOOS Show Chairman, spoke about the upcoming show, which will take place June 1 – 3 at Lakeside Mall. Judging of plants and exhibits will occur on Saturday, June 2. She asked members to consider volunteering at this year's show. We need volunteers to help with setting up and taking down our exhibit, working the raffle table and clerking for the judges the Saturday morning of the show. Sign-up lists for clerking and for the raffle table will be passed out among the membership. Income from raffle ticket sales helps to defray the costs associated with putting on the show. Marian mentioned that we have flyers which publicize the show. She asked members to take some flyers to display at commercial venues that they frequent. We also have NOOS business cards which are available for giving to members of the public who might be interested in joining NOOS.
- Peggy White encouraged members to volunteer to clerk for the judges at the show. She mentioned that in addition to having an excellent learning experience, clerks are treated to breakfast and lunch on the Saturday of the show.
- Ann Roth thanked members for their donations to the 2018 show trophy fund. She said that for the first time, we will be giving live orchid plants as trophies.
- Randy announced the good news that Russel Deroche is now cancer free.
- Carol Stauder announced that Ian Hiler is not doing well and is in home hospice.
- Randy reminded members to sign in to be eligible to win the door prize. He also reminded everyone to buy raffle tickets for the plants on tonight's raffle table. Tonight, in addition to the door prize and birthday raffle, there will be 8 plants for raffle. He also asked members to vote for tonight's best species flower, best hybrid flower, best grown plant and best featured category (Phalaenopsis) flower during the break.
