- Randy said that we had received requests for speakers from garden clubs in Belle Chasse and on the North shore. He asked members who would be interested in speaking to see him.
- Randy announced that long time member Max Mipro was no longer able to bring cake to the meetings. He announced that we would be passing around a sign-up list for members to volunteer to bring refreshments for the remainder of the year.
- Randy called upon Ann Roth to present Carol Stauder with the Orchid Digest Diamond Award for her outstanding service to NOOS. Ann spoke about Carol's many contributions, including serving two six-year commitments as Vice-President, President and Board member. Carol has also been a member of the show committee for many years. In that capacity, she has helped to set up exhibits, maintained and stored the black cloths used in our exhibits, handled the registration of plants, produced plant tags and handwritten plant labels. Carol receives plants to be exhibited in out-of-town shows at her house and prepares the labels for those plants. Carol helps Ann with managing the plants for the raffle table at our monthly meetings. Carol often serves as a personal tour guide for our guest speakers. She frequently gives presentations to newcomers in our Orchid Basics sessions. She also brings her plants to the meetings for table judging.
