Minutes of July 16, 2019 Meeting

President J.D. Breaux called the meeting to order.

Reports:

- Vice-President Randy Johnson said that the program for the August meeting had not yet been determined.
- Treasurer Peggy White gave a brief report.
- Secretary Ann Ebert introduced and welcomed several guests who were attending tonight's meeting. She also asked anyone who wished to join as new members tonight to see her at the break to complete a membership form and pay dues. Dues are \$20.00 for an individual; \$25.00 for a household.
- Molly Prokop asked members to see her if they wanted to order a NOOS name tag or have the NOOS logo embroidered on a shirt. A name tag costs \$6.50. Shirt embroidery costs \$10.00. tonight's door prize.

Old Business:

- J.D. said that he was sorry that he was unable to attend the July meeting. He thanked everyone for their work on the 2019 show.

New Business:

- J.D. said that he wanted to address the rules of order for our meetings and that he wants everyone to feel that they are being heard. He said that according to NOOS By-Laws, we should be following Robert's Rules of Order. He said that Robert's Rules of Order state that for small organizations, it may be better to follow the spirit, rather than the letter of the Rules. J.D. went over some of the provisions of Robert's Rules: call or motion for action; call for debate; raising your hand or standing to interrupt a speaker; appealing if president does something out of order; and call for census, which is done to get a feel for what the membership thinks.
- J.D. said that he wanted to discuss the member sales table that we sometimes have at our meetings. He said that he personally likes having the sales table, but is concerned because there are no rules for managing it. He said that it would take the majority of the membership to address this.
- J.D. asked members to raise their hands if they liked having the sales table at the meetings. There was a unanimous show of hands in favor of the sales table. J.D. also asked members to raise their hands if they thought there should be some rules governing the sales table. Although the majority of the members present indicated that they were not in favor of having rules, the members began a discussion.
- One of the members mentioned that there has been an unwritten rule that members not bring plants to sell on the same night that a guest speaker has plants to sell.
- Russel Deroche suggested that there should be no selling of plants while the meeting is going on, that members should be eligible to sell on a first come, first serve basis, and that sales at a meeting not be limited to just one member.

MINUTES OF 07/16/2019 MEETING continued

- Ann Roth stated that in the distant past, 10% of the sales proceeds made by a member went to the NOOS Treasury.
- Russel recommended that instead of the selling member giving a percentage of sales to NOOS, it would be best if the member made a donation to NOOS. That way, NOOS will not be liable for state sales tax.
- Randy mentioned that at the September meeting there will be a plant sale by members and a sale of the late Alice Barrios' orchid books.
- Christian Bordelon asked if NOOS was a 501c3 organization. Russel answered "No." Christian also said that she was unfamiliar with the NOOS By-Laws.
- Rob Schmidt moved that we close debate on the member sales table issue.
- Gayle Dellinger moved that the Board develop some proposed rules for the member sales table and bring them back to the membership for a vote. Ann Roth seconded the motion. J.D. said that he will schedule a Board meeting.
- J.D. said that Randy had been contacted by the Jefferson Beautification Society about NOOS having a table at their event to be held at LaSalle Park in Metairie this October. J.D. asked the membership if anyone was interested in participating at this event. No one expressed an interest.
- Refreshment committee chair Diane Seidemann asked for volunteers to bring refreshments for the upcoming meetings. She told members that she was leaving a sign-up sheet on the refreshment table.
- Randy said that we did not have our usual NOOS Show recap slide presentation at the June meeting due to technical difficulties. This will be rescheduled to a future date.
- J.D. reminded everyone to vote in tonight's table judging during the break.

Break and Plant Judging

J.D. thanked Joyce Peterson, Patricia Sander, Clarine Usher, Teresa Klainer, Nancy Dempsey and Diane for tonight's refreshments.

Program: Randy did a short presentation on how to look up plant parentage on the Royal Horticultural Society Orchid Registry. He also played an AOS Greenhouse Chat.

Plant judging results were presented by Ann Roth.

Plant raffle and door prize. Klaus Kallman won the birthday raffle.

The meeting was adjourned.
