Show Results

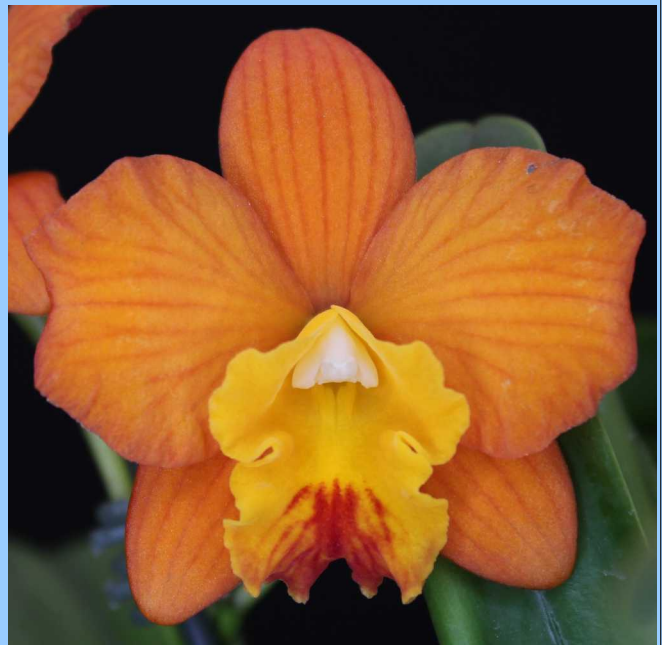

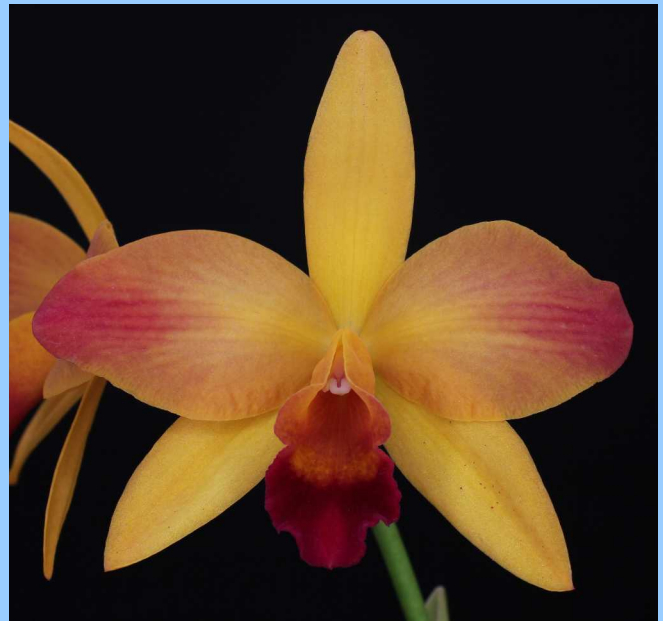


Paph. Pink Streamers 'TonyJo' AM/AOS 80 pts. exhibited by JoAnn Vaz

Twelve plants were submitted for monthly AOS judging at the Louisiana Judging Center on Saturday, May 27, 2022. A total of four plants were awarded.



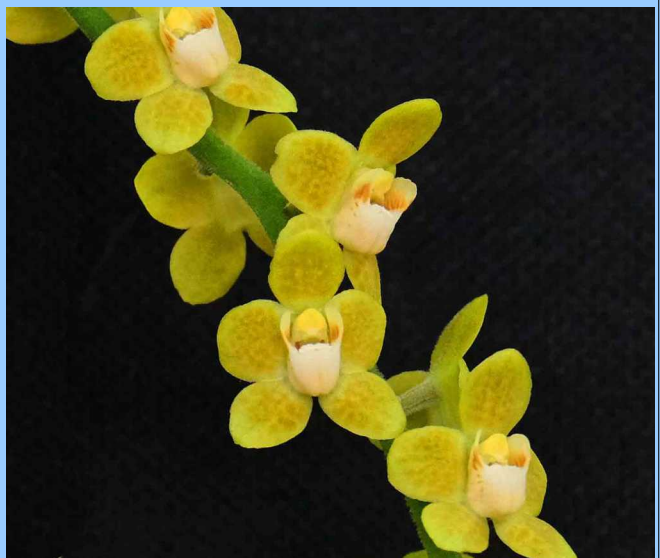
